A: To get the exact PDF version of the most recent version of the document, you can do: `pdftotext -lilu0 -pdf -layout -lz6 -lz2 -encoding ascii 'file.pdf' | grep -Po 'keyner.*?(\K[^\"]*"PDF)' | cut -d'" -f4` Where the `-lilu0` stands for line breaking info, the `-layout` shows the document's page layout, the `-lz6` for compressing the data, the `-lz2` for decompressing the data, and `-encoding ascii` means that we only care about ASCII text. The `\K` operator in the regex removes the part before the match. The resulting PDF is just called title (which is the second part of the title in the document) There are alternative methods such as the following which makes use of the fact that the URL in the document will point to the most recent PDF: `wget -O file.pdf ""` or `wget -O file.pdf ""` and then searching for "PDF" or "filename" or "title" with your pdf viewer. Your question is not very clear. Is it possible to open the PDF in a pdf viewer on your computer? If not, is there an alternative that you can use to get the result you are looking for?
